WHAT IS MICRO SCHOOLING WITH HOPKINS?

A small group (3- 6 students) of the same/similar age/grade working on similar skills. Our groups will need to happen OUTDOORS, so ideally in a shaded backyard space WITH MASKS to protect students and educators. Instruction is provided by a Hopkins Coach, who are highly qualified educators with current CO teaching licenses. Depending on the group's needs, instruction can last up to 2 hours (with breaks). The number of days per week will also depend on individual needs and scheduling.

YOUR ROLE AS A PARENT:

1. Complete this survey so we can gather information about your family's specific needs.
2. Talk to others in your child's grade/neighborhood to see if there's interest in your specific neighborhood. As we gather information about other families in your area, we will try to connect you to help form appropriate groups.
3. If we're able to form a group that will fit with your child's needs/schedule, one or two families from the group will need to commit to opening their outdoor space for the group. Hopkins cannot provide the space for micro schooling at this time.
4. You will be responsible for picking up and dropping off your child on time for each session. Educators will not be responsible for transportation and cannot stay after sessions for late pick ups. Parents will have to work together to support each other on this.
5. Make sure your child is adequately prepared for the session (fed, rested, NOT SICK, dressed appropriately for weather, with mask)
6. The host family must have an adult at home for the entire duration of the session. Our primary focus is providing supplemental instruction, not day care.

HOPKINS ROLE:

We will provide the education, curriculum, support materials, and the instructor. We are committed to excellence and professionalism. Therefore our educators will come on time, prepared, and will be available via phone and email to discuss specific student needs with parents on a weekly basis. Our teachers will also wear masks the entire time they are with students, and will take proper steps to ensure the health and safety of all students. Hopkins teachers also reserve the right to contact a parent to pick up their child if the child is sick, or whose behaviors are not conducive for group learning. (We recommend private tutoring, which we also offer, if this is the case with your child.) We are committed to providing this option to families through the first quarter, as weather permits. Depending on what's happening with the pandemic and school responses to it, we will reevaluate needs as we go.
